# Claim Form

To return no later than **March 5<sup>th</sup>, 2015**.

If you wish to make a claim in the class action of freelancers for *The Gazette* newspaper you must fill out this form.

Section 1 of this form will allow you to determine if you are eligible to make a claim. If you are eligible, you must answer the questions in all sections of this form. The instructions about how to submit this form are found in Section 5.

If you make a claim for a person other than yourself, you must indicate why the Claimant cannot sign the form him- or herself, and attach proof that you are his or her legal representative

## 1 Conditions of eligibility

*In order to determine if one or several of your articles published in The Gazette newspaper were produced in the INFOMART data base, you can consult data bases such as Proquest which is available in most public libraries.*

*For the purpose of the class action, the signature after 1996 of a contract giving The Gazette the right to reproduce your articles in electronic data bases is not considered a valid consent.*

In order to be eligible to receive payment in this class action, you must meet the following four conditions:
